CHEC Focus Group Findings

- ❖ Knowledge of the watershed varied by focus groups
- **❖** Those aware of watersheds were more willing to take action
- Students, community leaders and government officials were identified as key audiences
- ❖ Newspapers, TV and the Internet were most popular ways of receiving information

CHEC Focus Group Findings

- ❖ Nearly 100 organizations play a part in watershed information/protection
- Barriers to change included misinformation, apathy and animosity between northern and southern regions of the watershed
- Benefits identified included financial incentives, control of growth and more education

Percent	Response
51	Very concerned about water resources
50	Feel environment has become less desirable
32	Identified industry and stormwater runoff as main sources of pollution



<u>Key Findings - Landscape</u>


Percent	Response

30	Familiar with Florida-Friendly Landscaping







Percent	Response

22 - 24	Lower maintenance



The Need for Awareness

Conclusions

- Impracticable to "build" your way to reducing personal pollution

- Limited knowledge of personal impacts on pollution overall
- **❖** Increasing interest in the environment

- Motivation to take action appears to be more related to water conservation
